Schools provide students with free instruction to fulfil the standard Victorian Curriculum and we want to assure you that all contributions are voluntary. Nevertheless, the ongoing support of our families ensures that our school can offer the best possible education and support for our students. We want to thank you for all you support, whether that is through fundraising or volunteering your time. This has made a huge difference to our school and the programs we can offer.

Within our school this support has allowed us a wider offering of subjects and special curriculum experiences; enhanced digital learning opportunities, upgrade of our Apple iMac computer pod and faster WIFI and internet.

Financial Support for Families

Lilydale Heights College understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers a range of support options, including:

- CSEF Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund, which provides payments for eligible students to attend camps, sports and

- State Schools Relief
- Centrelink automated deductions on application minimum \$25-00
- Local community supports

Payment Methods

Parent voluntary financial contributions towards the requested payments is essential to maintain the quality of education that we provide at Lilydale Heights College. Parents are strongly encouraged to contribute to these funds.

- Option 1
 - Pay the full amount of Voluntary Financial Contributions for Curriculum items and or other curriculum items, on or before the 13th December 2022
- Option 2
 - o Payment Plans by instalments
 - o A deposit of \$200-00 using Credit Card only by 13th December 2022
 - With six (6) equal instalments of balance deducted on the 18th of each month commencing February 2023 through to July 2023
 - o Compass online payment plans
- Option 3
 - Centrepay Applications to be completed and returned to the General Office by 13th December 2022, with an agreed minimum deduction amount of \$25-00. This is automatically deducted from a fortnightly Centrelink payment.
